World Book Day

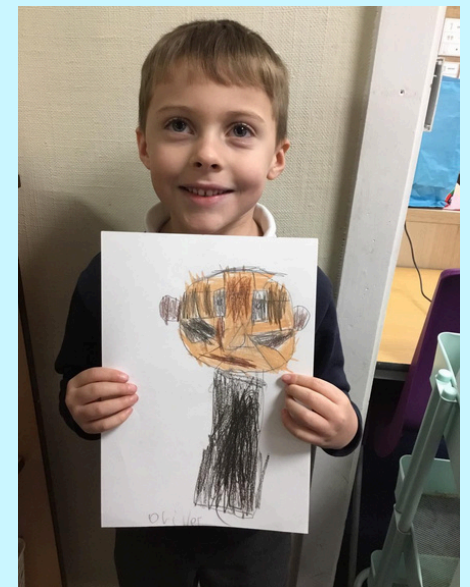
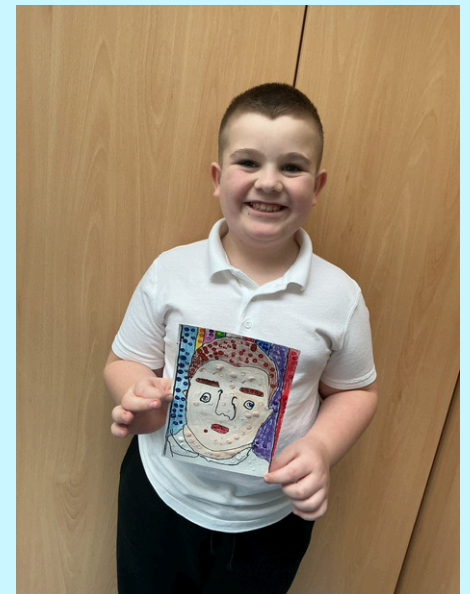
We are inviting pupils to dress up as their favourite book character on Thursday 5th March. This is entirely optional and if pupils do not wish to dress up, they don't have to.
